
Hooded

You'll notice these eyes are set so the natural crease in the eyelid is not readily seen. By creating a well-defined lashline, you can capture the charisma of these eyes while adding dimension to their appearance.

- Highlighter shade: Apply to brow bone and along the upper lashline and inner corner of lower lashes.
- Midtone shade: Apply from the base of the upper lashline and over the entire hooded area to help the lid appear to recede. Blend.
- Accent shade: Apply from the base of the lashline and over the entire hooded area to help it appear to recede and blend. Sweep the accent color underneath the lower lashes to define. Hooded eyes really benefit from well-defined lashlines — upper and lower.
- Eyeliner: Glide onto upper lashline and along lower lashline from outside corner to inside edge of the iris. Soften with the Eyeliner/Eyebrow Brush, if desired.
- 5. Mascara: Apply to upper and to lower lashes.


