How do I clean the brush head for my Skinvigorate™ Cleansing Brush? How do I clean the cleansing brush?

- •With the Skinvigorate™ Cleansing Brush turned off, detach brush head. Clean cleansing brush and brush head with warm soapy water to remove any residue and rinse well. Gently dry off the cleansing brush and brush head; lay brush head bristles facing up to air dry. It is not recommended to clean the cleansing brush or brush head with abrasive cleansers or chemicals; and do not put any part of the cleansing brush or brush head in a dishwasher.
- •It is recommended to rinse the brush head and lay bristles facing up to air dry, after each use. It is recommended to clean the brush head each week, or as makeup residue build-up is visual.
- •Remember, although the Skinvigorate™ Cleansing Brush is waterproof, it is not recommended to fully submerge in water.

Can I use the Mary Kay® Brush Cleaner to clean the brush head?

•Yes, you can use the Mary Kay® Brush Cleaner on the brush head of the Skinvigorate™ Cleansing Brush; it is recommended that the brush head be thoroughly dry before applying the Mary Kay® Brush Cleaner. Once dry, saturate the bristles with the Mary Kay® Brush Cleaner and allow it to dry before use.
