There are three ways to automatically update Android apps. Check out all the methods below to see what works for you. Method 1: Use the Play Store settings to automatically update Android apps. You can turn on the automatic app update feature in the Play Store to keep apps up to date on your Android device by following these steps: 1. Charge your phone. 2. Look in the top left corner and you will find an icon with three thin horizontal lines. This is the print menu. 3. You can see several options in the menu. To go all the way down, swipe up and find Settings. 4. In the "Settings" section, look for the option that shows automatic updates of applications. Press Option and a small window will appear. 5. Now you will see the options: Apps will be updated automatically whenever you want. Data transfer charges may apply. Method 2: Use my Play Store for Apps & Games to update Android apps automatically. You can automatically update Android apps by going to the apps list. Note. If you previously disabled this setting, it is no longer available. 1.
